VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Dog Walking

Duties: Walk, play with, socialize, and train leashed dogs on the shelter property. The walker must also pick up after the dog with a plastic bag.

Skills needed: Experience with dogs, physical strength and stamina.

Hours: Primarily early morning and late afternoon hours, but can be any time of day.

Cat Cleaning

Duties: Cleaning and disinfecting cat cages and cage equipment including food and water bowls, litter boxes, blankets, and toys. Also, petting and socializing cats and kittens. May include cleaning small animal cages.

Skills needed: Experience with and ability to handle cats, physical stamina, ability to work both quickly and thoroughly.

Hours: Primarily morning hours

General Shelter Cleaning

Duties: Washing dishes, laundry, sweeping/mopping, stocking and organizing supplies, cleaning rooms, taking out garbage.

Skills needed: Physical strength and stamina

Hours: Primarily mornings but also needed all day

Animal Socializer

Duties: Help socialize animals that have not had much human contact or are scared or stressed in order to make them more comfortable and adoptable.

Skills needed: Experience with cats and/or dogs and knowledge of animal behavior.

Hours: Any time of day

Shelter Maintenance

Duties: Deep Cleaning, Painting, Mowing Grass/Trimming, Planting/Watering/Weeding Flower Beds, Kennel and Fencing Maintenance, Securing hardware/Repairs

Skills Needed: Maintenance experience

Hours: Any time of day
